

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

**Business Meeting

April 15th, 2009

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Warren Riedenhauer, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Otis Hogan and Danny Holmes, Fiscal Officer and Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present with the exception of McCoy. Visitors present were Drew Warburton with Orr Cadillac, and Bryan Hunt with Mountaineer Power Sports. Hearing Officer Peggy Johnson and Court Reporter Susan Whitson attended.

The minutes from the March 18th, 2009, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

The Director's report was presented and approved. The Commission was presented with a list of new motor vehicle dealership that have been recently closed or are in the process of closing. The Commission also discussed dealer lender issues.

Director Kirkpatrick reported to the Commission the legislative updates.

Legal Counsel had no issues at this time.

The Commission moved on the agenda to H#09-006 AMVC vs. Orr Cadillac. After hearing testimony from Dana Brown and reviewing the exhibits presented, the Commission found Orr Cadillac in violation of Commission rules and statutes by advertising new motor vehicle without the proper disclosures and issued a penalty in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00).

The Commission then heard H#08-010 Spring Valley Motors vs. Mountaineer Power Sports. The complainant was not present for the hearing. After testimony from Mr. Bryan Hunt from Mountaineer Power Sports and reviewing documents entered into evidence, the Commission found no violations made by Mountaineer Power Sports. The Commission issued no penalty and considers this matter closed.

The Commission then heard H#09-001 AMVC vs. Jonesboro Cycle & ATV. The respondent was not present. After hearing testimony from Investigator Hogan, License Supervisor, Vicki Wright and reviewing documents submitted into evidence the Commission found that Jonesboro Cycle & ATV violated Commission statutes and was penalized in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00).

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
