

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

August 19th, 2009

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Joe Morgan. Staff present were Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Jennifer Padgett Fiscal Manager, Investigators Otis Hogan and Danny Holmes, Secretary Angela Stoffer, Legal Counsel Arnold Jochums. All Commissioners were present. No visitors were present.

The minutes from the August 19, 2009, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

The Director's report was presented and approved. The yearly sales and representatives renewal was reviewed. The Director discussed the Commission Retreat in November. The Commissioners were provided with a copy of the Financial Impact Statement.

Legal Counsel reported no legal updates at this time.

The Ad Hoc Committee presented its finding to the Commission to fine a dealer, two thousand hundred dollars (\$2,000.00). The Commission approved this fine for advertising violations.

The Commission held the scheduled hearing H#09-011 Rule 4 Facility Requirements which was approved as written.

The Commission held the scheduled hearing H#09-012 Rule 5 Specialty Vehicles which was approved as written.

The Commission then held H#09-010 AMVC vs. R C D Holdings. The respondent was not present for the hearing after receiving proper notice. The Commission found R C D Holdings was

in violation of Commission statutes for selling product to an unlicensed dealer and upheld the Ad Hoc Committee's recommendation of one thousand hundred dollars, (\$1,000.00).

The Commission finally discussed the cash for clunkers program in terms of payments to dealerships.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Morgan.
