

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

**Business Meeting

January 18th, 2006

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:32 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Danny Holmes, Ken Burks and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present. Also in attendance, Dennis Hogland from AMDA, and Mr. Dennis Jungmeyer from AADA.

The minutes for the Commission meeting of November 16th, 2005, were approved as written.

The Director's report was reviewed and accepted. Director Kirkpatrick reviewed a letter that is to be sent to General Motors in regards to the Certificate Program in addition to updating the Commission on the South West Truck Discount program. The Commission body requested that we contact other states in regards to the program and ask how or if they have addressed the issue(s). Director Kirkpatrick discussed his Strategic Plan for 2006 with the Commission members and staff. The discussion included: (1) The possibility of removing the ability for dealers to use disclosures; (2) A request to investigate advertising of \$99 down \$99 month advertising was made, and (3) An Investigation Report is going to be designed to inform the Commission body of the types of investigations that are being done.

Director Kirkpatrick informed the Commission of the Ad Hoc Committee findings and recommendations. Legal findings were discussed as well as current court cases by Mr. Jochums.

Proposed additions to Rule 4 Facility Requirements were provided to Commissioners and attendees with a request for review and recommendations.

Proposed Rule 9 Delivery Prior to Sale/Spot Delivery was brought to the Commission for a request to start the rule making procedures. Motion was made and approved.

Mr. Jungmeyer made the Commission aware that union activity was present in Northwest Arkansas and expressed the AADA's concern.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
