

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

February 20th, 2008

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Danny Holmes and Otis Hogan, Fiscal & Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present with the exception of Commissioners Wallace and McCoy. Guests included Randy Coger, Richard Coger, Bettina Coger, and Paula Means representing Office Saver and Ozark ATV's.

The minutes from the January 16th, 2008, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

The Director's report was reviewed and accepted.

Director Kirkpatrick informed the Commission members of the progress of the new office space the Commission will be moving into shortly.

Director Kirkpatrick advised the Commission of the Ad Hoc Committee findings, which were approved as presented.

The Commission agreed to postpone the review of the proposed changes to Rule 3 Advertising until the Commission meeting in March.

The Commission then reviewed the possibility of amending Rule 7 Off-Premise Display, Sales and Events to allow dealers from multiple counties to attend Off-Premise Sales. The Commission recommended the staff review the rule and offer their suggestions at the March meeting.

The Commission moved to H#08-002, AMVC vs. Office Saver, Richard Coger, Ozark ATV's and Randall Coger. The respondents were found guilty of charges one (1) and two (2) and a civil penalty was issued for five hundred dollars (\$500) per charge for a total of one thousand dollars (\$1000).

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
