

**MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Otis Hogan and Danny Holmes, Fiscal Officer and Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present with the exception of McCoy and Futrell. Visitors present were Bryan Berman and Ken Shemin with Rogers Outdoor Sports. Hearing Officer Peggy Johnson and Court Reporter Susan Whitson attended.

The minutes from the January 21, 2009, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

The Director's report was presented and approved. The Commission was presented the termination guide for dealerships.

Director Kirkpatrick reported to the Commission the legislative updates along with the new guidelines initiated by Legislative Audit.

Legal Counsel had no issues at this time.

The Commission moved on the agenda to H#08-026 AMVC vs. Rogers Outdoor Sports. After hearing testimony from Director Kirkpatrick, Investigator Holmes, Bryan Berman and reviewing the exhibits presented, the Commission found Rogers Outdoor Sports in violation of Commission statutes by distributing product without a license and penalized the dealership two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

The Commission reviewed the Chrysler Bonus Program and agreed to write a letter to the manufacturer outlining the possible violations of Arkansas statutes.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
