

**MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION**

The telephone conference meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present with the exception of Commissioners Morgan and Teeter.

Rule 7 Off-Premise Sales, Displays, and Events was approved as written to begin the rule making process.

The Commission received a judgment on Van Houten Motors Bond from Al Fava a distributor. The Commission reviewed the judgment and decided not to pursue the request based upon the interpretation of the current law that the remedy is limited to the protection of retail buyers and not to creditors or financial institutions.

The Commission also received a judgment on Farmer Blagg Motors on behalf of a creditor, Merchants and Farmers Bank, the Commission decided not to pursue the request based upon the interpretation of the current law that the remedy is limited the protection of retail buyers and not to creditors or financial institutions.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
