

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Danny Holmes and Otis Hogan, Fiscal & Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. Commissioners present were Stroope, Ferguson, Teeter, Blankenship and by telephone conference Morgan.

The minutes from March 21, 2007, were not reviewed and are scheduled to be approved at the next Commission meeting.

The Commission moved forward on the agenda to the public hearing on Rule 8-Dealer Service and Handling Fees. The Commission voted to adopt the rule as presented.

Director Kirkpatrick advised the Commission of the Ad Hoc Committee findings which were approved as presented.

The Commission voted to begin the rulemaking procedure to amend Rule 3 Advertising.

The election of Officers was moved to the Commission's next monthly meeting.

Director Kirkpatrick was informed by Commissioner Teeter that consumers are being stopped for having tags from their trade in on their newly purchased vehicle, and requested that DFA be contacted to correct the problem with the Garland County Sheriff's Department.

The Director's report was accepted as presented.

Director Kirkpatrick informed the Commission a new Commissioner, Mr. Jimmy Jones, had been appointed to replace Commissioner Albright.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
