

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnie Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Otis Hogan and Danny Holmes, Fiscal Officer and Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present. Guests included the following individuals: Mr. Matthew Miller, Administrative Rules Counsel Bureau of Legislative Research.

The minutes from the July 16, 2008, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

The financial report was presented by Dana Brown.

The investigation report was presented by Danny Holmes.

The Director's report was presented and approved.

Legal Counsel had no issues at this time.

The ad hoc recommendations were approved as presented.

The Commission held Hearing #08-017 on Rule 3 Advertising. The motion was made by Commission Wallace and seconded by Commissioner Blankenship. All Commissioners, with the exception of Mr. Teeter who was not present during the vote, approved the rule as written.

The Commission then held Hearing #08-018 Rule 7 Off-Premise Sales, Displays and Events. The motion was made by Commissioner Wallace and seconded by Commissioner Blankenship. All Commissioners, with the exception of Mr. Teeter who was not present during the vote, approved the rule as written.

Director Kirkpatrick brought before the Commission the matter of Regency Conversions. The Commission was asked to review whether Regency fit the definition of the Commission's second stage manufacturer and should be licensed. After discussion, the Commission concluded that Regency did not meet the definition of second stage manufacturer as they do not assemble, install or affix a body, cab, or special equipment to the chassis or substantially modify an assembled motor vehicle.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
