

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

September 19th, 2007

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:35 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present were Legal Counsel Arnold Jochums, Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigators Danny Holmes and Otis Hogan, Fiscal & Communications Manager Dana Brown, and Secretary Angela Stoffer. All Commissioners were present with the exception of Commissioner Blankenship.

The minutes from the July 18, 2007, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

A presentation was made to former Commissioner Keith Cogswell for his time and service with the Commission.

Director Kirkpatrick informed the Commission body of the method of quicker response time to complaints and investigations based on the staff's ability and resolve.

Director Kirkpatrick made the Commission aware of the suit filed by the Arkansas Attorney General's office regarding McKay Hyundai.

The Director's report was reviewed and accepted.

Dana Brown reported to the Commission the progression of the Advertising Rule. Vicki Wright presented the Commission with the new renewal forms for Dealers, Manufacturers and Distributors that are being sent out this year. Angela Stoffer advised the Commission of the temporary permits that have been issued in accordance with the new statute.

Director Kirkpatrick advised the Commission of the Ad Hoc Committee findings, which were approved as presented.

Moving on the agenda Rule 5 Limitation on sales of new motor vehicles proposed changes were reviewed and approved for the rule making process.

The Commission body discussed at length, warranty issues that have been brought before the Commission. Director Kirkpatrick recommended meeting with the dealer associations before any action is taken by the Commission.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Stroope.
